

RULES

- 1. There will be a 1 hour 5 minute time limit on all pool games and 1 hour 15 minute time limit on all elimination games (play out the inning). This includes all pool games and the single-elimination tournament. Pool games can end in a tie. The championship game will not have a time limit, unless coaches agree before the game starts.
- 2. The international tiebreaker rule will be used in the single-elimination tournament. This includes the championship game.
- 3. Run Rule for all games: 12 Runs after 3 innings; 10 Runs after 4 innings; 8 Runs after 5 innings
- 4. Teams will flip for home team before each pool game. The higher seed team will be the home team throughout the single-elimination tournament.
- 5. Home team will be the official scorebook.
- 6. Tournament-Style infield/outfield ONLY before games start. NO soft-toss into fences.
- 7. Forfeit score is recorded as 7-0 (Pool Play)
- 8. TSSAA rules will be followed with the exception of the run rule and international tie-breaker rule.
- 9. Seeding for the tournament (1-19) will be based on a team's won-loss record. Seeding will take place after the last pool game.

In the event of ties:

- 1. Head to head competition (only if 2 teams are tied: If 3 or more- go to fewest runs allowed)
- 2. Fewest runs allowed in all games
- 3. Run differential (runs scored minus runs allowed)
- 4. Coin toss
- 10. Admission will be charged as follows:

Adults - \$5.00 per day
Seniors - \$4.00 per day (65 or older)
Children 6-12 - \$2.00 per day
Children 5 & under – Free

Adult Tournament passes - \$12 (for teams playing on Thursday)

- 11. This is a tobacco free park. No forms of tobacco inside the Sportsplex.
- 12. Fans are not allowed to bring food or drinks into the Sportsplex. (Please pass this rule along to fans).
- 13. Teams will provide softballs (1 New, 1 Good, to start every game) Please use the brand softball your state has approved
- 14. Teams that bring school buses need to park buses in Pringles Parking lot or Complex B.
